## VERSE 1

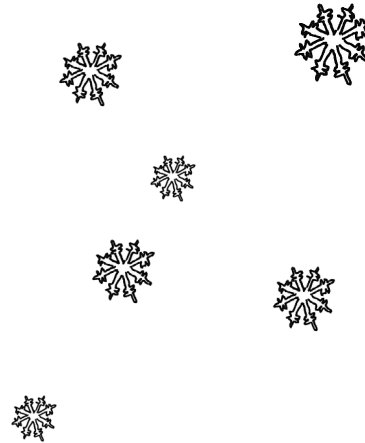
This is the way we clap our hands,

In these verses I have used one action that makes a sound and one that does not ( or is extremely quiet!) to concentrate on dynamics. Using the louder action encourages louder singing voices, and the opposite, when using quieter voices.

Finding actions that help the children to think creatively about the 'colour' of the sound (ie. is it a scratchy sound/sharp sound/continuous sound?) is another way of focussing their listening and attention musically.
