### DRAMA 6: The Performance (KS1/KS2)

#### It's Performance Day!

I am going to be helping you on how to set up your performance, how to make it feel like the real deal and make your very own professional play come to life!

Now you've rehearsed, you have everything you need to put together a spectacular Puppet Show and it's going to be great! **You can take any of these ideas as you like, you don't have to do them all.**

#### Top Five Tips!

##### 1. Invites!

- a. In the theatre, we always advertise our play. If no one knows about it they won't no it exists. Maybe you would like to make a poster that has the title, the time and date of your play so that everyone will know when it is happening.
- b. You can also send a virtual invite, ask for a grown-up's help to take a photo of your poster and send it to family or friends who might not live with you so that they know you have made a show!

##### 2. Tickets!

- a. Once you know who is attending your play you can make them tickets, in the theatre we use tickets for every performance so that we know who will be coming to see.
- b. Again, you can send virtual tickets out to everyone who might want one!

##### 3. Snacks!

- a. Maybe you would like to set up a little snack shop outside of your theatre by the door. So that the audience can get excited to sit down and watch a real performance.
- b. But when they enter your theatre make sure to take their tickets from them!

##### 4. Seating

- a. Make sure your audience know where to sit so that they can watch your play! Maybe set out some cushions or put some chairs where you want them.
- b. You might be performing your play live by video call, for your friends and family who don't live with you. If so, place your device in the best location so that they can see!

##### 5. THE SHOW!

- a. Now you are ready!
- b. The moment we have all been waiting for!
- c. Lights, Camera, Action off you go perform the best puppet show!

#### Bonus Tips:

1. Do try and make a video of your play to send to school.
2. Perform more than once if you like, many theatres have a play running multiple times.

3. Be confident, you are amazing, your show will be amazing to. Have as much fun as possible!

I really hope this will inspire you to make all sorts of different theatre in the future. I believe drama is a really fun way to bring your imagination to life, and allows you to gain in confidence and to be as creative as you want to be.
