LAND ARMY SONG

- Setting: A country field
- Description: An overcast, wet day in a muddy field where you are preparing the ground for the sowing of crops
- Characters: Experienced farmers and city living volunteers

ONION SONG

- Setting: A smart music room and a large kitchen in a stately home
- Description: Velvet sofas, a grand piano and walls filled with books and a large kitchen, able to serve a large house
- Characters: Residents of the house who wear fine clothes and smoking jackets. Think Noel Coward

D-DAY

- Setting: Multiple venues. The family sitting room, their street and outside the factory
- Description: We are a company of players who are taking on multiple roles to tell this story. Sometimes narrators sometimes individual characters
- Characters: Our family roles, soldiers and narrators

THE BLITZ

- Setting: A Hackney street or The Underground Shelter
- Description: At the beginning the street would be intact but after the raid there would be nothing left, just piles of rubble and the remains of your homes and belongings.
- OR The Shelter will fill up with people and belongings – favourite objects they don't want to lose or practical items like bedding
- Characters: Women, Neighbours, Mothers, Children, Air Raid Warden
